Briefing on “Public Consultation on Review of the Patent System in Hong Kong”

The current patent system of Hong Kong has been in place for more than a decade, affording statutory protection that meets international standards. To ensure that the system continues to meet present-day circumstances and that its future positioning is in alignment with our vision to develop Hong Kong into a regional innovation and technology hub, the Government decided to conduct a comprehensive review, taking into account the latest international developments in patent protection. A consultation paper was issued in October 2011, seeking views from the public and stakeholders on a review of the patent system in Hong Kong. The consultation period will last until 31 December, 2011.

The Intellectual Property Department, HKSAR Government is organising the captioned briefing. A representative from the Government will explain details of the consultation paper and answer any queries from the participants during the briefing. Enterprises may know more about the issues raised in the consultation paper, including whether and, if so how the patent system should be enhanced.
