

## OGP filings by local / non-local applicants


Local applicants 46.7%

# <u>Technical areas of OGP grants</u> (<u>Total of 173 OGP grants</u>)



## **Advantages in applying for OGPs**

- Eligible for "patent box" profits tax concessions
- Direct filing for standard patent protection
- Obtain global priority date quickly and at lower costs<sup>1</sup>
- Enjoy 12-month provisional filing flexibility
- File in Chinese or English
- Easy communication with local patent examiners
- Accelerate examination by up to 3 months



#### Reducing examination time for OGP applications by filing confirmation of no amendments

After entering the substantive examination stage, applicants may submit written confirmation to the Patents Registry that their OGP applications do not require voluntary amendments, which can save the examination time by up to three months<sup>2</sup>.

# <u>Deferral of formality examination of OGP applications</u>

Applicants can request deferral of formality examination for a maximum period of up to 12 months from the filing or priority date.

#### **Benefits**

- Establishes an early priority date as soon as practicable
- Enables quick filing before impending public disclosure of the invention
- Delays the deadline imposed under the normal procedures for submitting claims
- Defers the costs required for prosecution of patent applications in Hong Kong
- Offers applicants more time to assess the patentability and commercial potential of the invention
- Offers applicants more time to seek funding for R&D or patent prosecution if needed

#### Requirements to be met before requesting deferral:

- Minimum requirement fulfilled
- · No request for early publication made
- · No deficiency letter issued

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> If an OGP application for an invention is first filed in Hong Kong, and within 12 months thereafter, a corresponding patent application for the same invention is filed outside Hong Kong in a Paris Convention country or World Trade Organization member country, territory or area, priority may generally be claimed on the basis of this OGP application.
