The Madrid System of international registration of trade marks is an international arrangement which seeks to facilitate the registration and management of trademarks in different jurisdictions. Under the Madrid System, an owner may apply for registration of trade marks in one or more countries or territories by filing a single application and paying one set of fees. The Madrid Protocol currently does not apply to Hong Kong. The Government has reviewed the matter and we believe that it would be in Hong Kong's overall interest for the Madrid Protocol to apply to Hong Kong so that we can take advantage of the Madrid System.
