RECLASSIFICATION OF SPECIFICATION OF GOODS OR SERVICES OF REGISTERED TRADE MARKS

The Registrar of Trade Marks has made proposals for amendment under rule 59/60 of the Trade Marks Rules (Cap. 559 sub. leg.) for reclassification of the specification in respect of the following registration(s).

Under rule 61 of the Trade Marks Rules, any person claiming to be affected by the proposed amendment may, within 3 months after the date of this publication, file a notice of opposition to the proposals on Form T6. (For example, if the publication date is 4 April 2003, the last day of the 3-month period is 4 July 2003.) The notice of opposition shall include a statement of the grounds of opposition, which statement shall, in particular, explain how the opponent would be affected by the amendments if they were made and why in the opponent's opinion the amendments would be contrary to section 58(5) of the Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap. 559).

It should be noted that under rule 95 of the Trade Marks Rules, extension of time cannot be allowed for filing the notice of opposition.
